

POTOMAC VALLEY SKIERS, INC.

For those who do not yet know, Potomac Valley Skiers (PVS), a non-profit organization devoted to "educational, social and athletic pursuits with particular reference to the sport of skiing" was incorporated under the laws of the District of Columbia on November 16, 1965. This is our birthday and please note it in your 1966 calendar so you won't miss the first anniversary celebration.

The first meeting of the PVS membership was held in Arnold's Hofbrau on Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., at 8 p.m. on November 17. A ski movie preceded the formal meeting which was presided over by Dick King, President Protem. Dick took the occasion to read and explain the PVS Constitution and By-Laws. A discussion of future PVS plans followed as part of a general question and answer period.

This week PVS made application for membership in the United States Eastern Amateur Ski Association.

PVS plans a two-day ski and get-acquainted trip to Seven Springs on 8-9 January. The trip will be made by chartered bus (departure on Friday evening, 7 January) with Bill Stecher in charge of both travel and room arrangements. Lodging will be at Seven Springs resort itself. Members and their friends are invited. An inter-ski club racing event (the Beezers of Baltimore will be at Seven Springs on the same dates) will be one of the highlights of the trip.

The First Annual Pennsylvania Ski Ball will be held in the new Park Ballroom at the Sheraton Park Hotel in Washington on January 15, 1966. The Ball is sponsored by the Pennsylvania Society of Washington. PVS plans a table at this event. Please look for your fellow PVS members.

The Blue Ridge Ski Council will hold a slalom race at Blue Knob on December 18. PVS members who want to participate in this event should make application to Mike Grady (telephone 933-4671) before 12 December.

Because election of PVS officers will not be held until the annual election meeting in April, volunteers are sought for interim positions of club secretary, treasurer, program director, etc. See Dick King for details.
