SECTION I - Membership
B. An intended member who is not a charter member is termed an applicant. An applicant must:

1. Be invited and sponsored by an active member of the club in good standing.
2. Attend at least two meetings of the club by invitation of an active member.
3. Submit a written application of membership.
4. Take no less than three ski trips in the company of members.
5. Pass the USSA Jniform Basic Ski Test or equivalent.

## PROPOSED:

SECTION I - Membership
B. An intended member who is not a charter member is termed an applicant. An applicant must:

1. Be invited and sponsored by an active member of the club in good standing.
2. Submit a written application of membership together with dues.
3. No application may be acted upon by the membership committee for active membership until the following provisions have been met.
a. have attended at least two meetings of the club. b. have taken at least three ski trips in the company of member (s). c. have passed the USSA Uniform Basic Ski Test or an equivalent.
